



FAMILY SERVICE HOURS

Program Description

- Each family is required to contribute 20 service hours to the school during school year.
- The purpose of these hours is multi-fold:
 - Encourage more participation of the school community
 - Enable the school to operate with less dependency on monetary assistance
 - Provide enrichment opportunities for the students
- Service hours for a given year can be documented from August 1 to July 31.

Monetary Contribution

- Families will be billed \$10.00 for every hour not served at the end of the school year.
- Families can contribute the monetary equivalent at any time to fulfill the service hour commitment. For example, a family may volunteer 10 service hours in the first and second quarters, then donate \$100 in January to finish the rest of their commitment.

Service Hour Documentation

- Service hours should be documented on the attached sheet and turned in when completed.
- If no sheet is turned in at the end of the school year, the family will be billed for the full service amount of \$200.00.

Serving of Hours

- Service Hours can be served at school or home, as determined by the necessary activity.
- Opportunities will be made available and advertised throughout the school year. Families should not feel limited to these options for service hours. If you have an idea of a service you can provide the school, please contact the Main Office to make an appointment with the principal for approval.
- Examples of service hours are provided.
