

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

It's time to register for the 2010-2011 school year! Please review the enclosed packet and complete the following steps. Forms need to be returned with your registration fee by Friday, February 19, 2010.

1. Read the entire registration application.
2. Complete all enclosed forms. Check to make sure you have signed all the required spaces.
3. Enclose a check made payable to "Resurrection School" for the appropriate amount, including the registration fee for our Extension Program if you plan to use our services.
4. Limited financial assistance is available for parish families. The application form for the Private School Aid Service is available on the *myinfopage*. Click on "Downloadable Forms" and scroll to "Important Documents". This service provides us information to help determine tuition assistance. Applicants meet with Fr. Jason Trull after processing is completed.

IN-PARISH TUITION GUIDELINES (not applicable to PK3 or PK4 tuitions)

- **RESURRECTION PARISHIONERS:** To receive the in-parish tuition rate, families must submit a letter from the parish that they are a contributing member of Resurrection. Families submitting applications without this letter will be charged the non-parish tuition rate.
- **FAMILIES AT PARISHES WITHOUT SCHOOLS:** Families from parishes that do not have a school must submit a letter from their parish stating that they are a contributing member of that parish to receive the in-parish rate. Applications without this letter will be charged the non-parish rate.
- **FAMILIES AT PARISHES WITH FULL SCHOOLS:** Families from parishes that have a school whose classes are full must submit a letter from that parish that they are a contributing member of that parish to receive the in-parish rate. Class status will be verified by the principal.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Registration will be open to Resurrection Catholic Church parishioners after Friday, February 19, 2010 and to the general public on March 1, 2010 on a space available basis. Current families who do not register by February 19 will have to pay the late registration fee and relinquish their priority standing.
- Applications will not be processed without the necessary registration fee.
- If tuition payment agreements for the current year have not been met, any monies collected will be applied to fulfill the 2009-2010 commitment before being used towards next year's registration.
